- National Cybersecurity Awareness Month
- How to Stay Safe Online
- Cybersecurity is the protection of computer systems and networks from attacks by malicious actors that may result in unauthorized information disclosure, theft of, or damage to hardware, software, or data...
- Wherever there is technology, there needs to be cybersecurity to keep our data safe.
- 4 Easy Ways to Stay Safe Online
 - o Strong password and password manager
 - Create strong passwords that are long, unique, and random
 - Use a password manager to store passwords, alerts you of duplicate passwords, generates strong new passwords, some automatically fill in your login credentials into a website, and it won't fall for phishing website
 - o Turn on multifactor authentication
 - A code or security key sent to your phone, email, or authenticator app
 - Biometrics such as fingerprint and facial recognition
 - Use for email and accounts with financial and personal information
 - Recognize and report phishing attacks
 - Phishing red flags are the tone is urgent or scary, sender email address does not match the company it's coming from, unexpected communication, requests to send personal information, and misspelled words, bad grammar, and odd URLs
 - Don't click on any links you don't trust, delete the email/text, don't click any attachments you were not expecting or recognize, and don't send personal information online or over the phone

- Do verify the communication is real and contact the sender directly through known phone numbers or emails, report it to UHS IT Security using the Report Phish button, and delete it
- Update your software
 - Updates ensure your devices and apps are protected from the latest threats, don't click on "remind me later" as it could leave you vulnerable to cyber threats, and automatic updates are the easiest way to stay secure
- Common Ways Identity is Stolen
 - o Data breaches and leaks
 - Phishing emails and phone scams
 - Skimming and card theft
 - o Online scams using social engineering tactics
- Steps to Take After Being a Victim of Identity Theft
 - o File a complaint with the Federal Trade Commission (FTC)
 - o Contact your bank or credit card company immediately
 - o Consider placing a fraud alert on your credit report
- Tips for Preventing Identity Theft
 - o Monitor your accounts and credit reports regularly
 - o Use strong passwords and enable 2FA
 - o Avoid sharing personal or financial information online
 - Be cautious when using public computers or devices

 - o Insured women coming for mammograms makes things possible for uninsured women to get mammograms and treatment.
 - Because The Rose is nonprofit, proceeds, if The Rose had been a for profit, are used for insured women to get a mammogram and treatment if needed.
 - The Rose provides ultrasounds, biopsy, screening mammograms, diagnostic mammograms, and testing.

- o Uninsured women must meet qualifications of \$62,000 or less income for family of 4 or \$400 \$500 a week for 1 person.





Policy number

01.A.08 - Travel Policy

Describe your concern or suggestion.

The concern is with the Embargo Form. I understand that the travel policy is being revamped to align with Concur now but one change that has been occurring that we were not doing originally is requiring the Provost Signature on the Embargo Form. Section 3.3.6 states that we need approval from the ORSP, if required. The form clearly states that if you answered "Yes" to one of more of questions (a) through (d) or if you answered "No" to question (e) then we are to contract ORSP to obtain approval. So why are we required to get the provost signature on every Embargo Form, which usually takes at least a week for it to be signed. Once we receive it back, then we submit the travel request in Concur to be approved by all including the provost (again) in Concur. It's a "double" approval for the same thing.

In your opinion, what is the best resolution to this issue?

I believe the best solution to this is to go back to the regular process, which follows policy and not obtain the provost's signature. Upload the document and the provost's approval in Concur will confirm that they are approving the documents attached also. Another option is to require someone else to sign the document, other than the provost. While this will still take more time, at least the provost is not "double" approving something.



OVERALL SATISFACTION




How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the overall performance of the 2023-2024 UHD Staff Council?



COMMUNICATION EFFECTIVENESS




How effectively does the UHD Staff Council communicate with its members?
