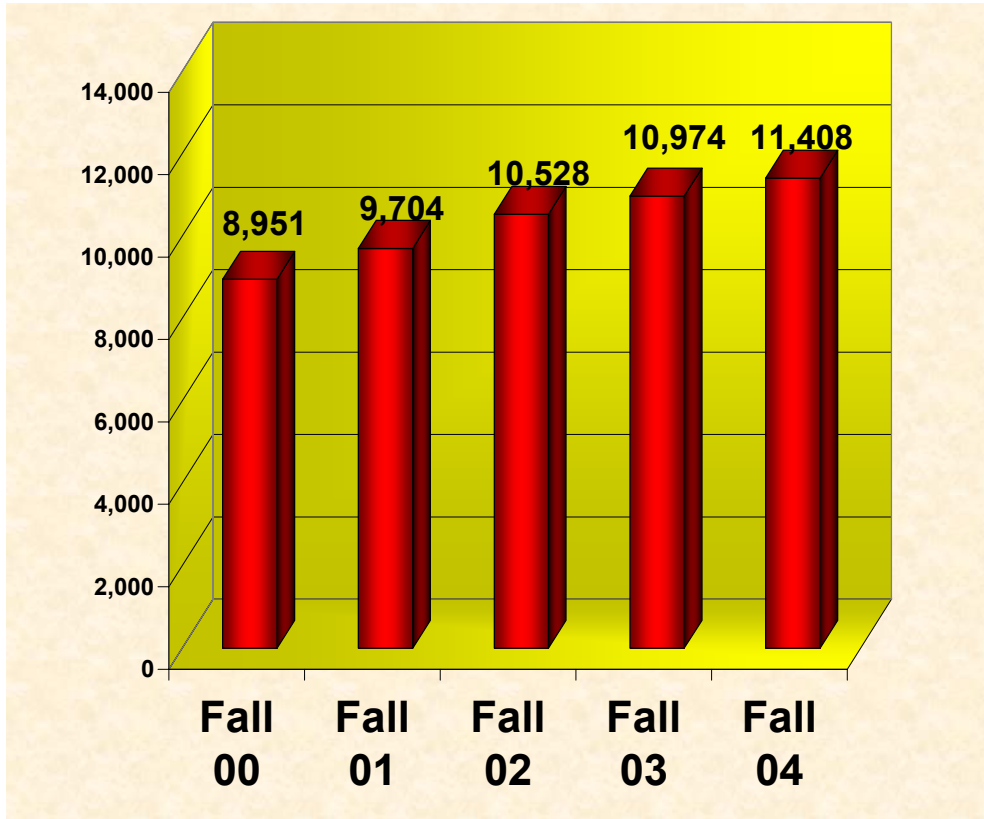

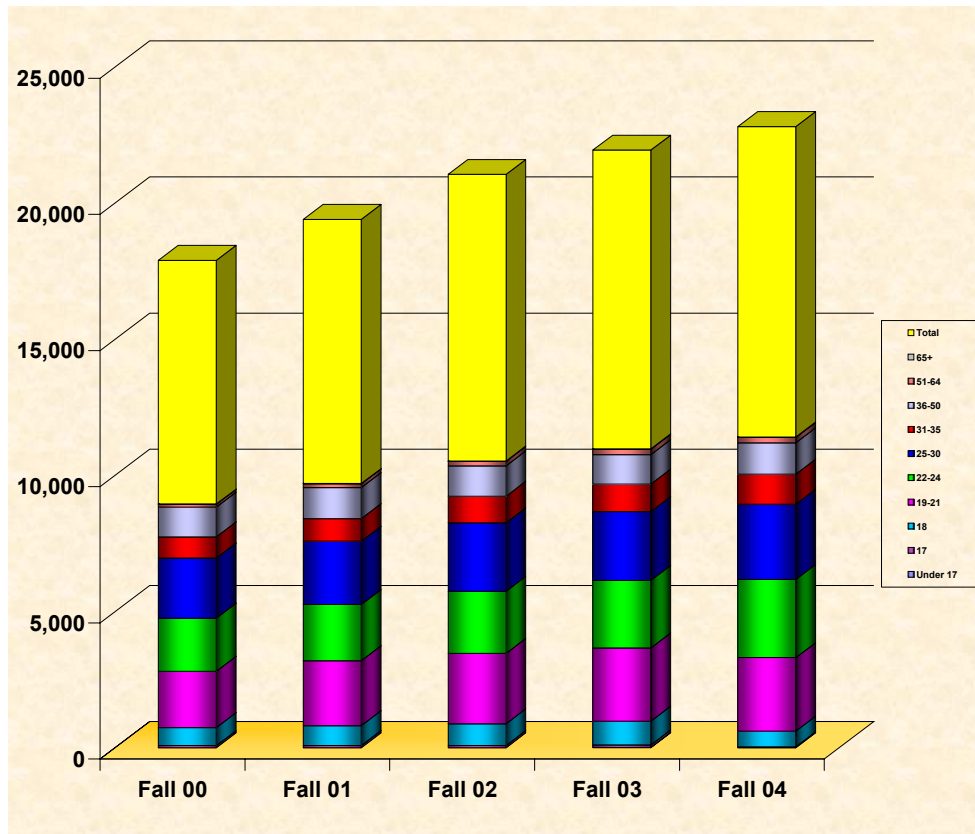

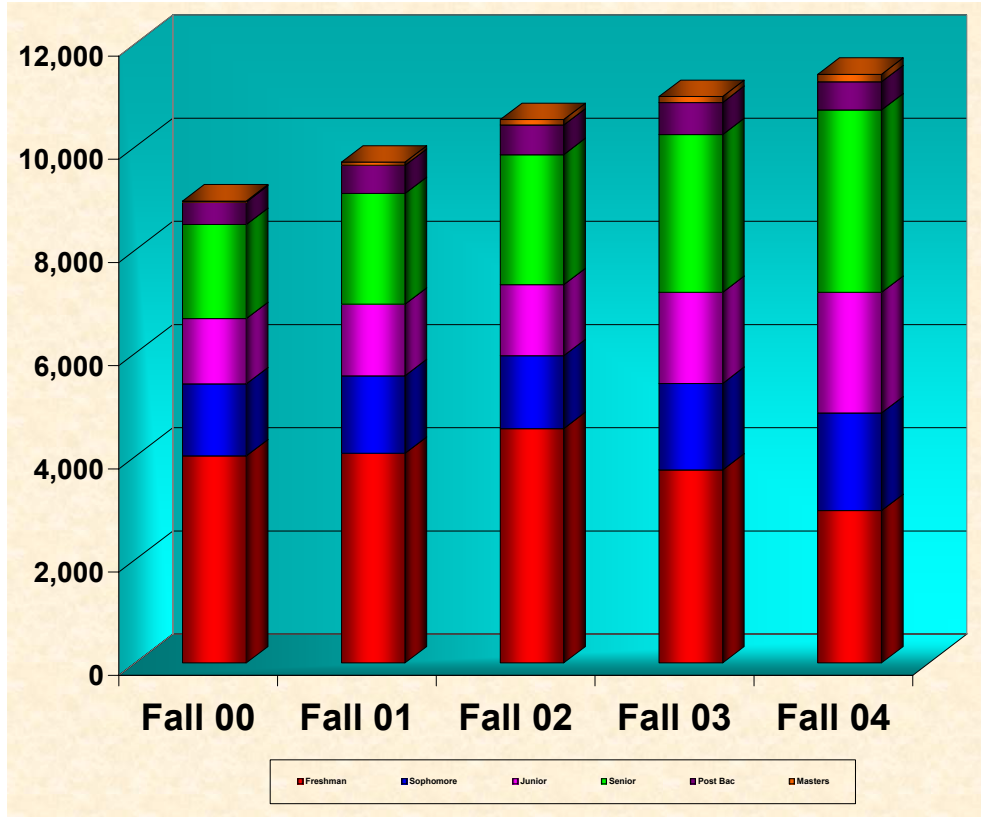

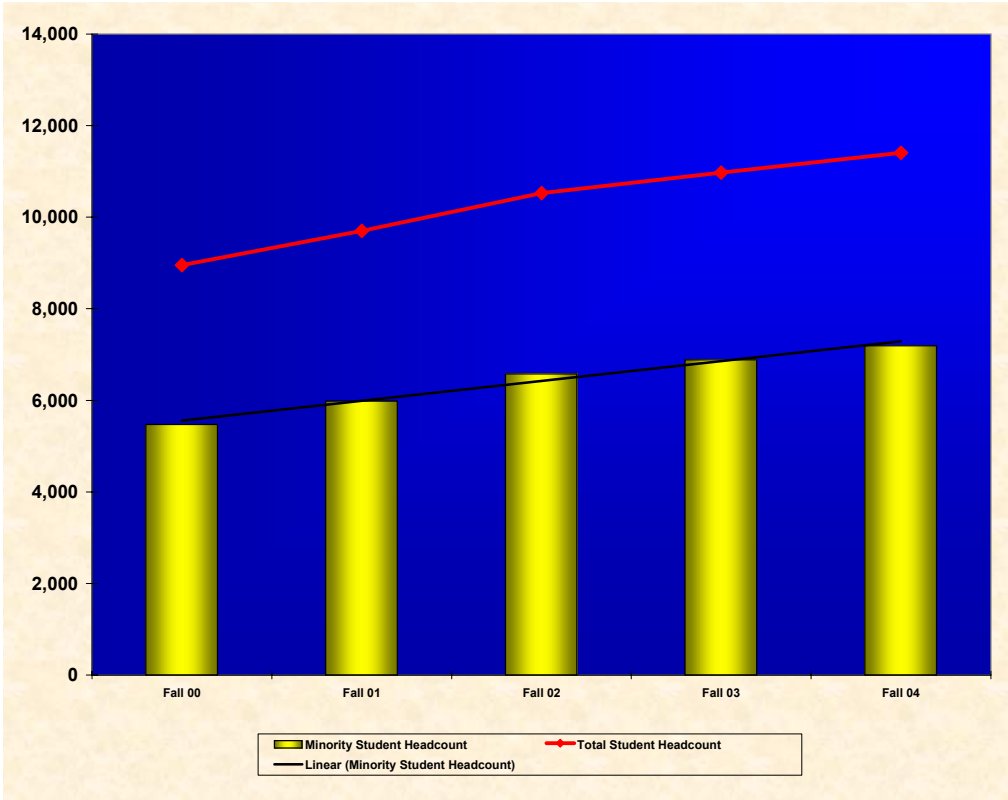

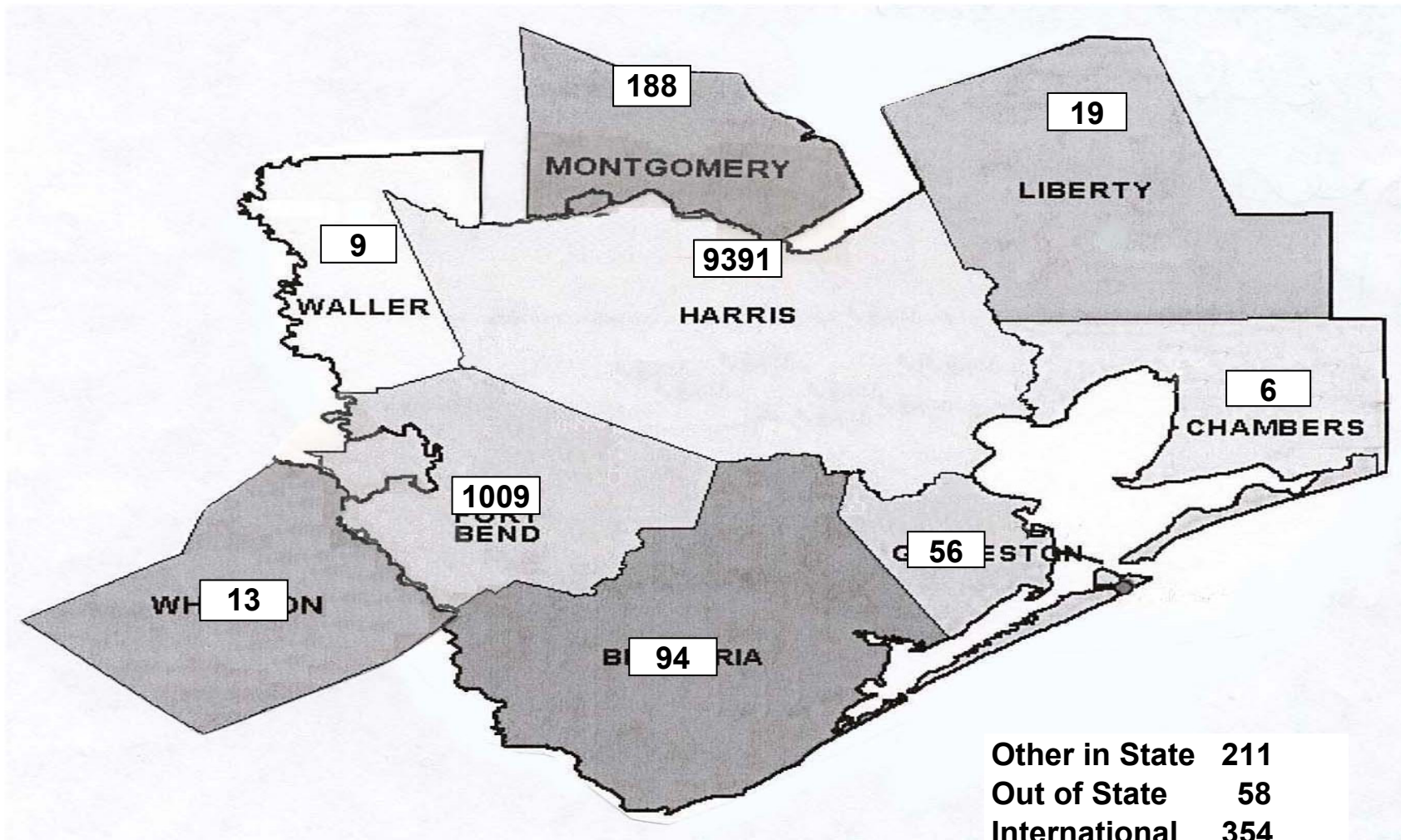

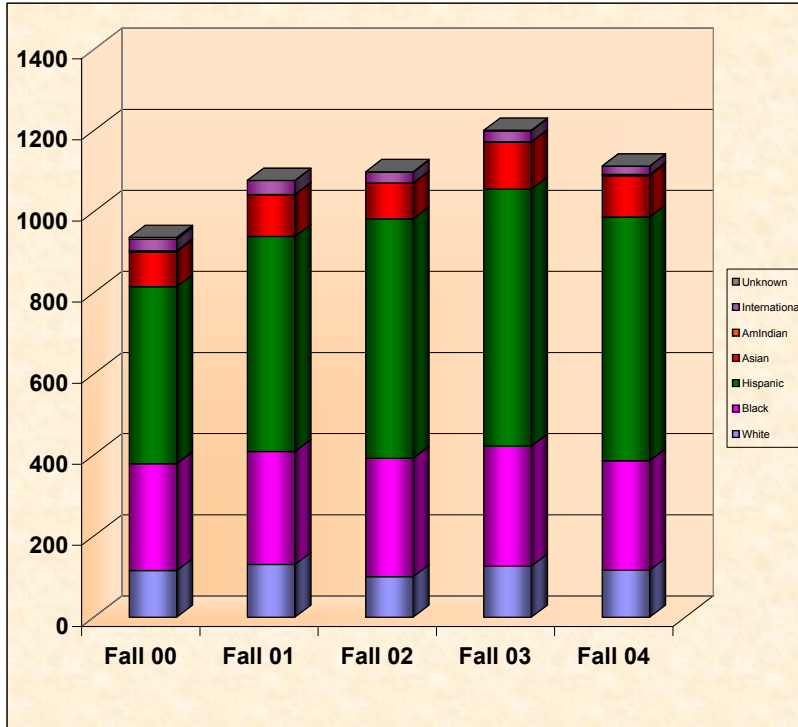
Total Student Headcount Enrollment by Residence

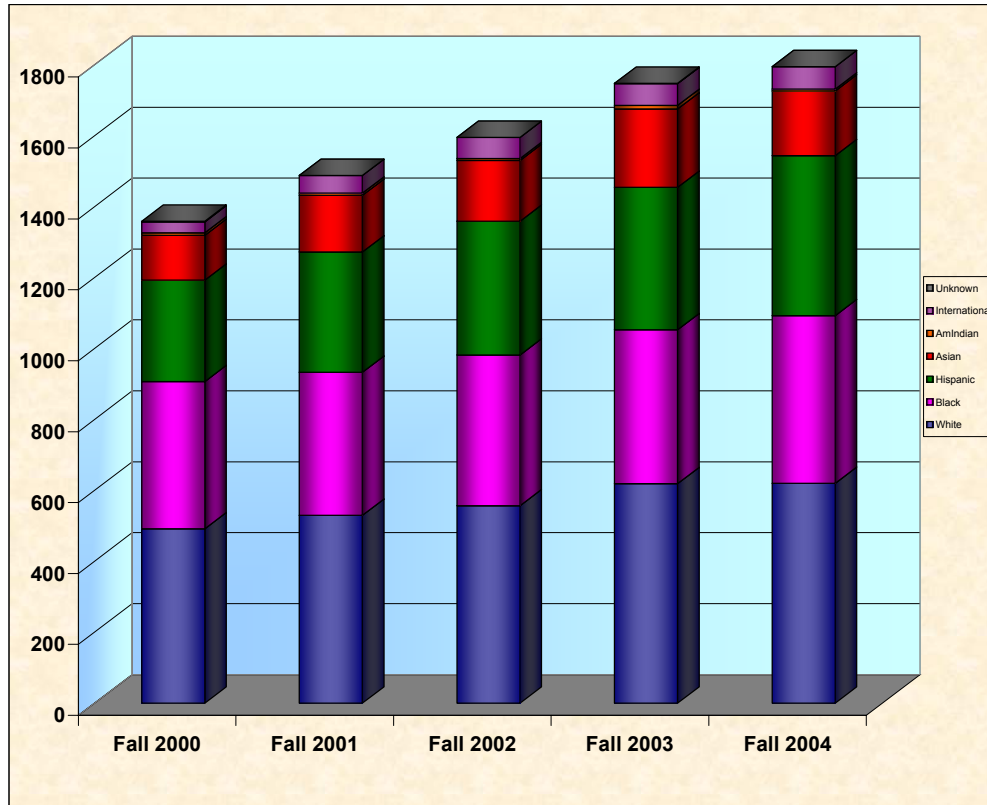

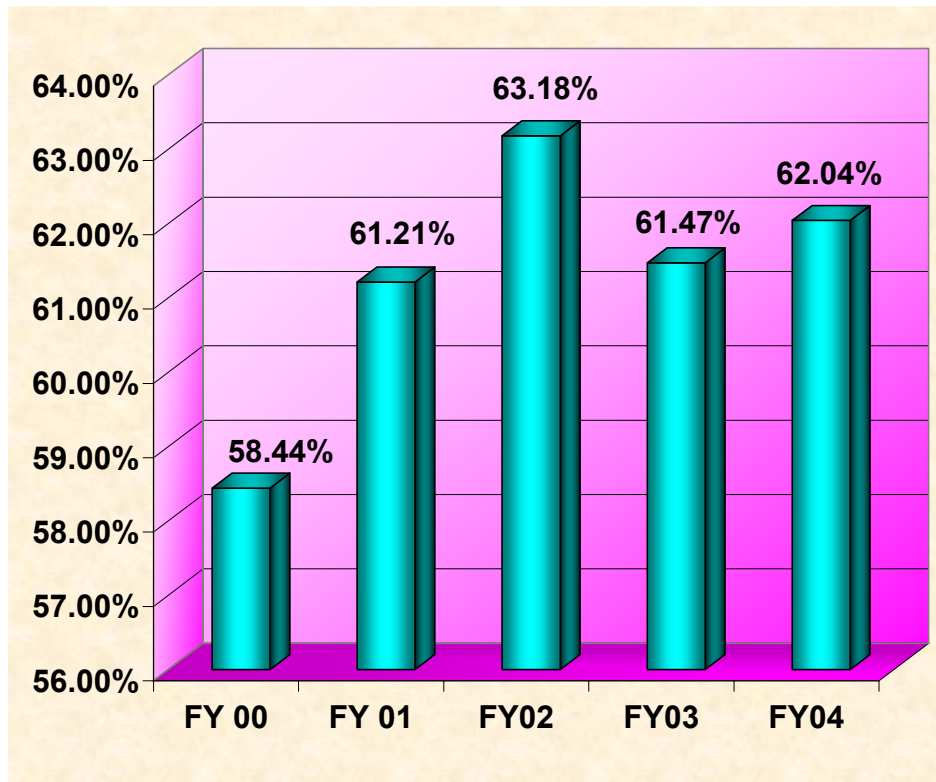

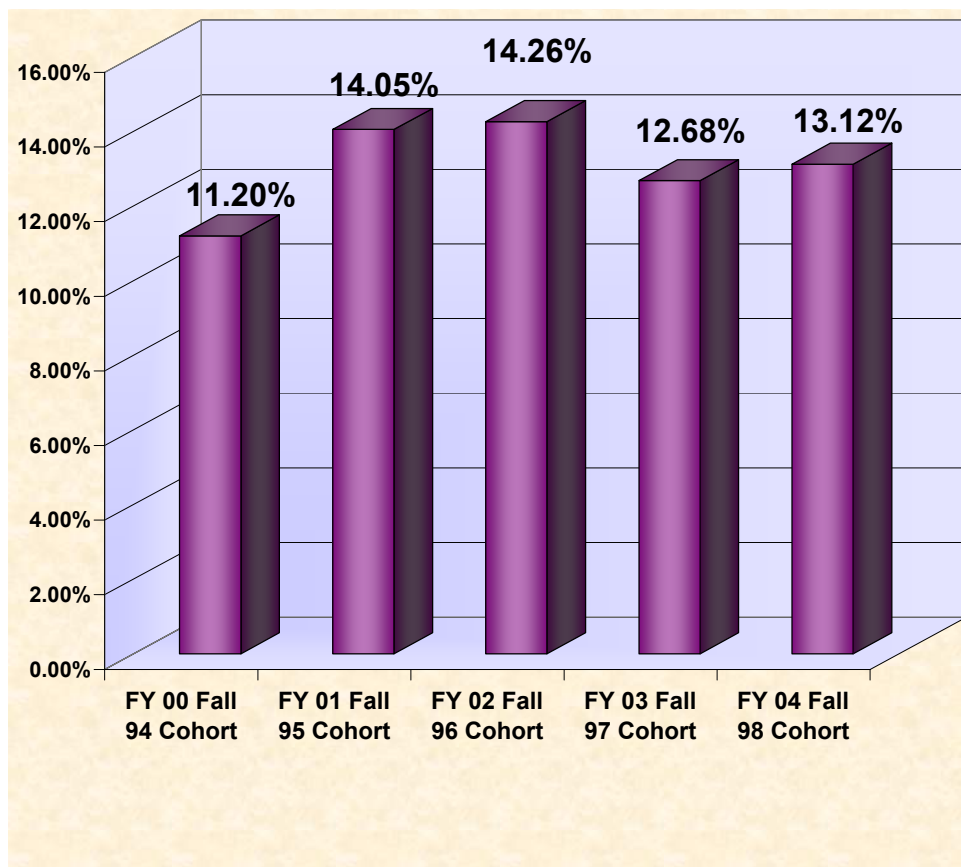

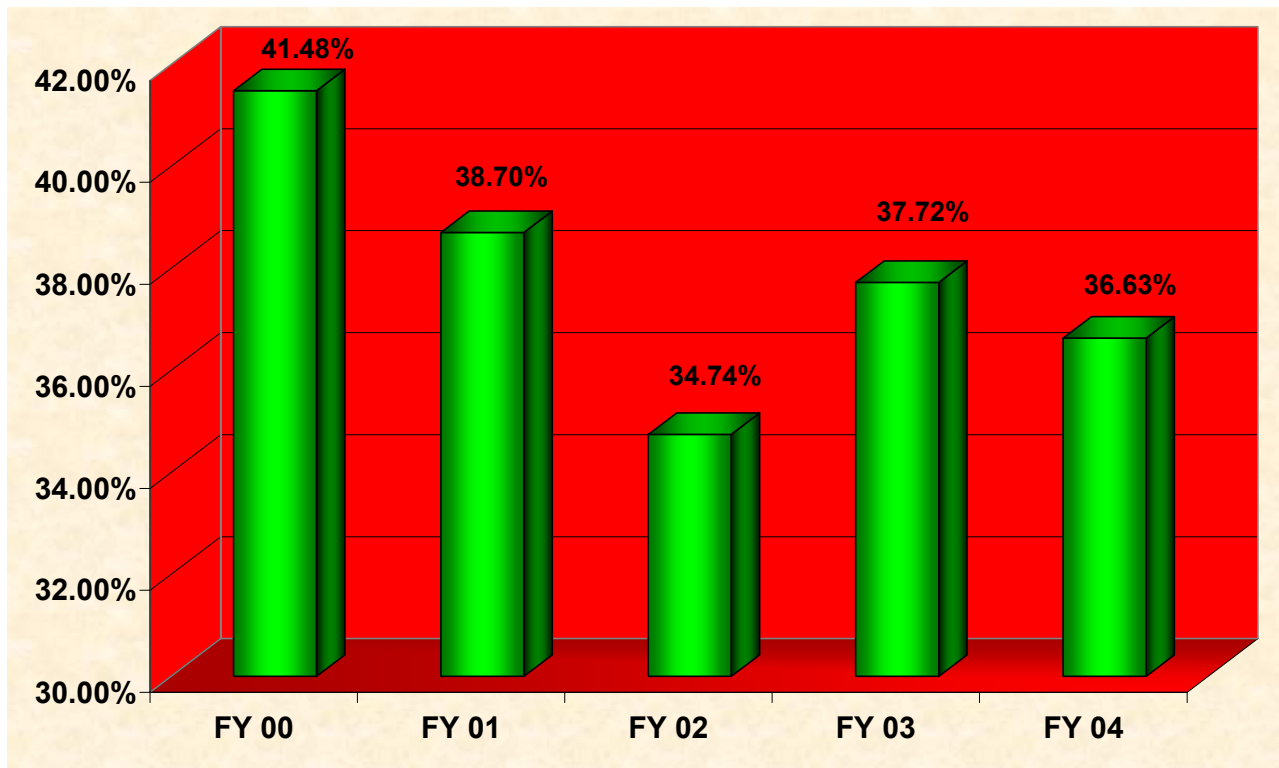

Tenure Track Faculty**

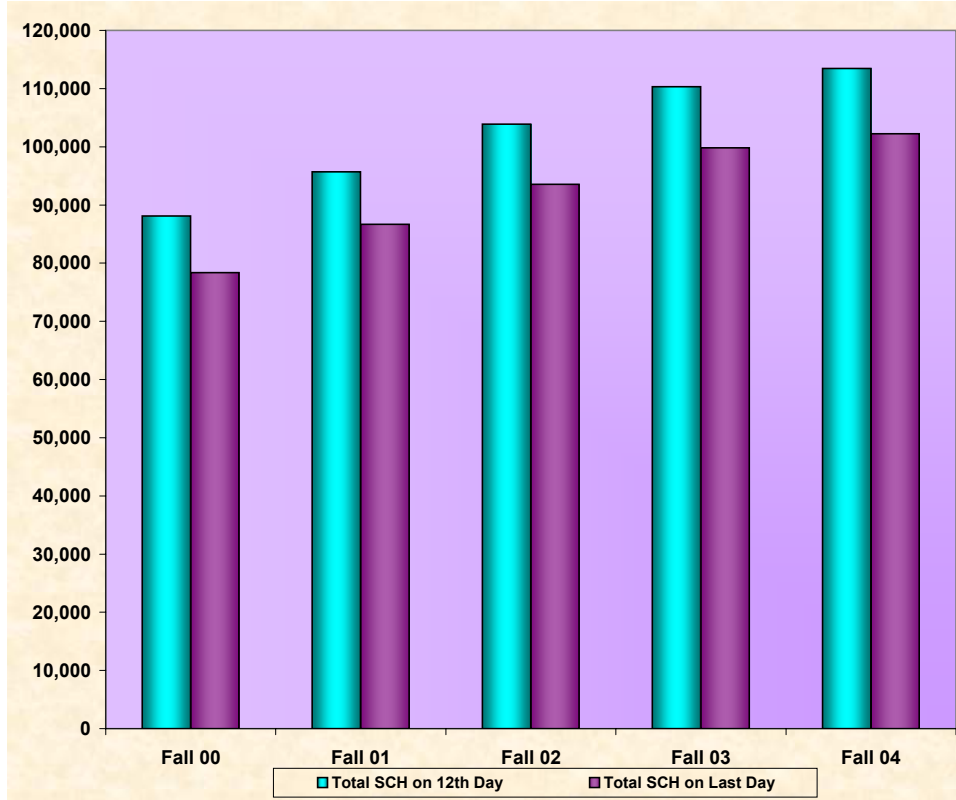

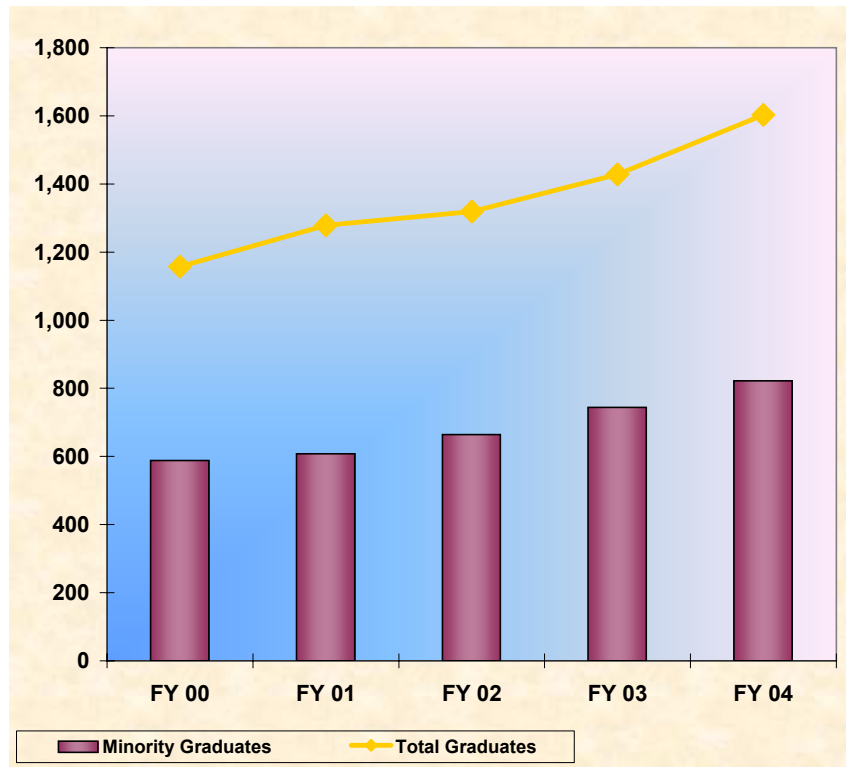

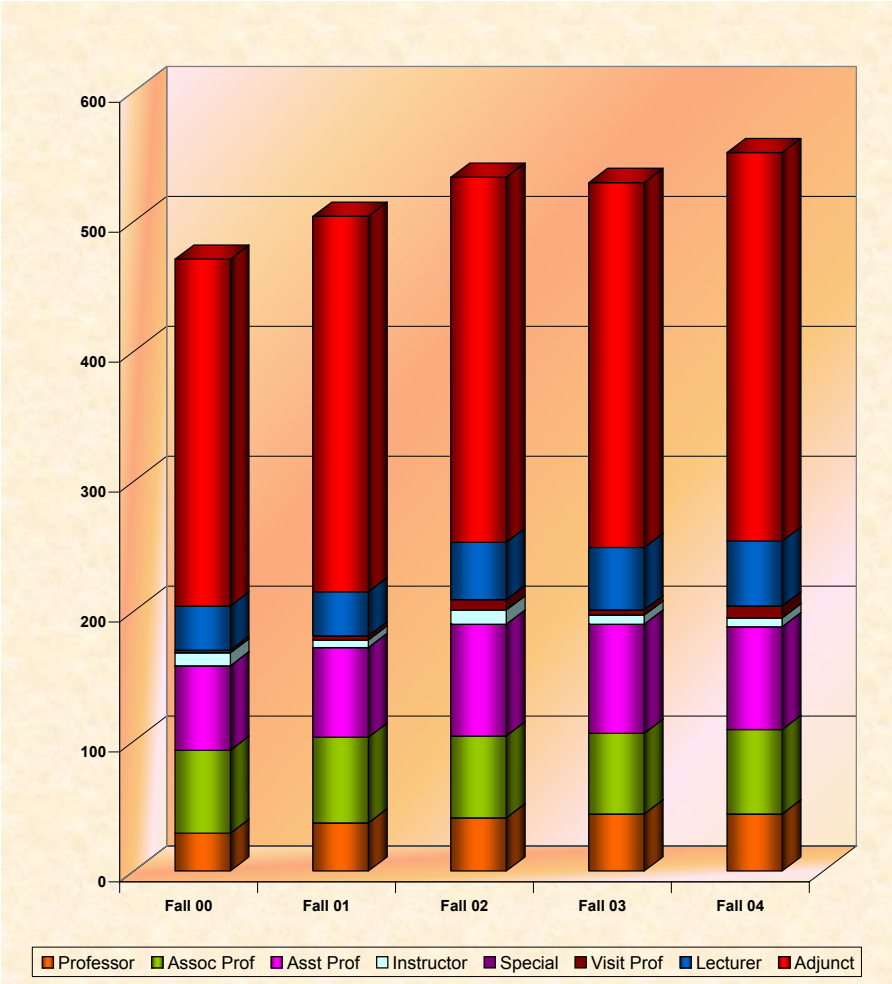

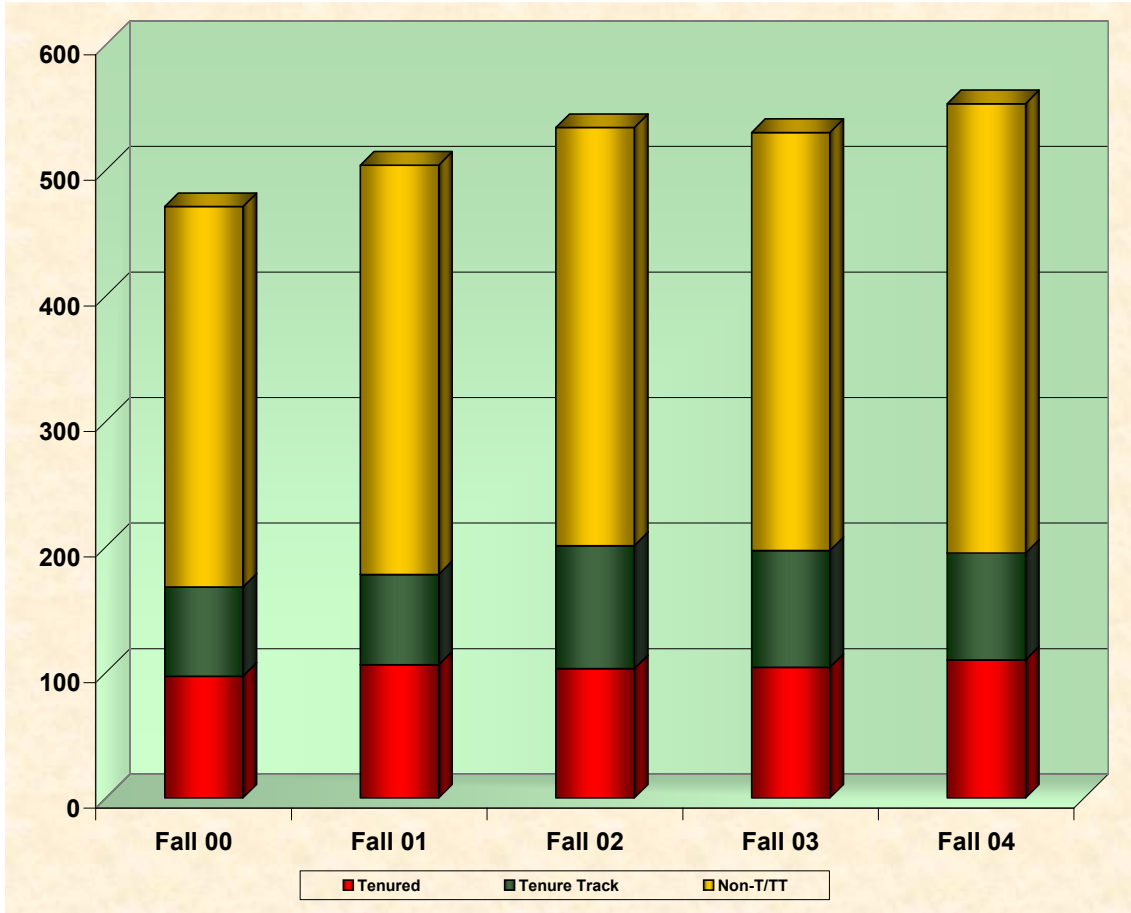

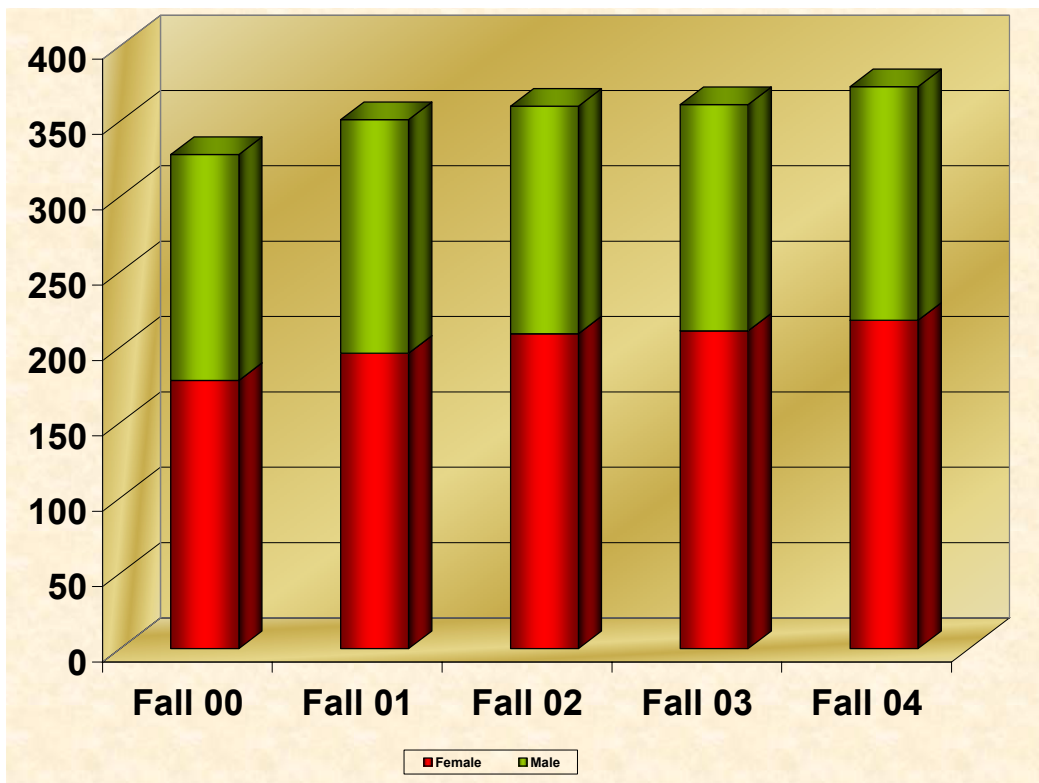

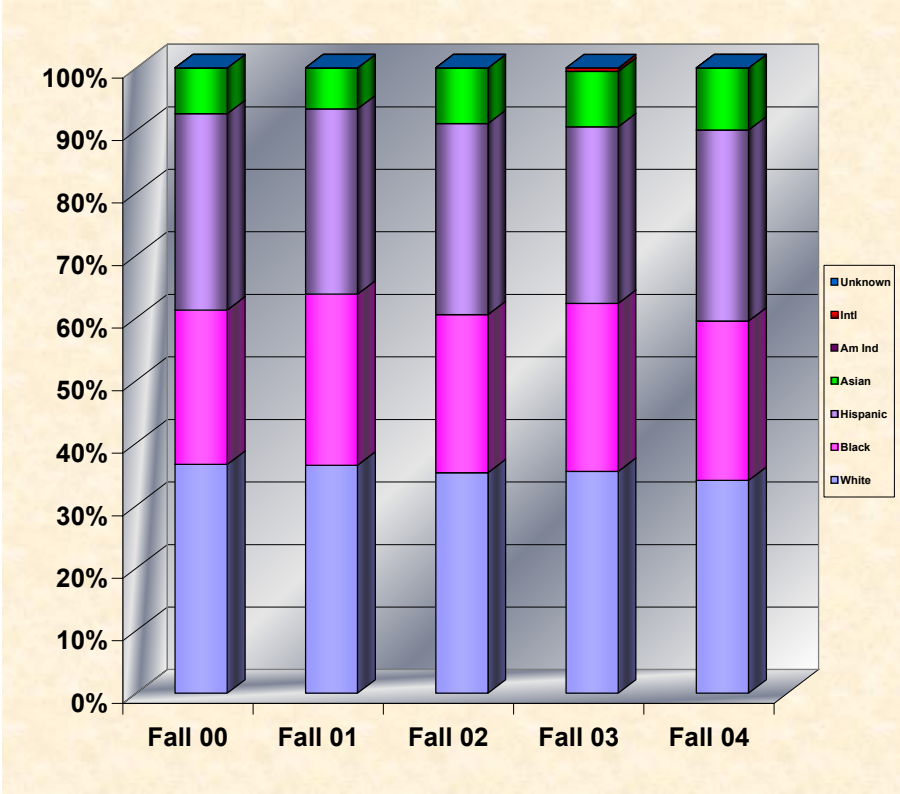

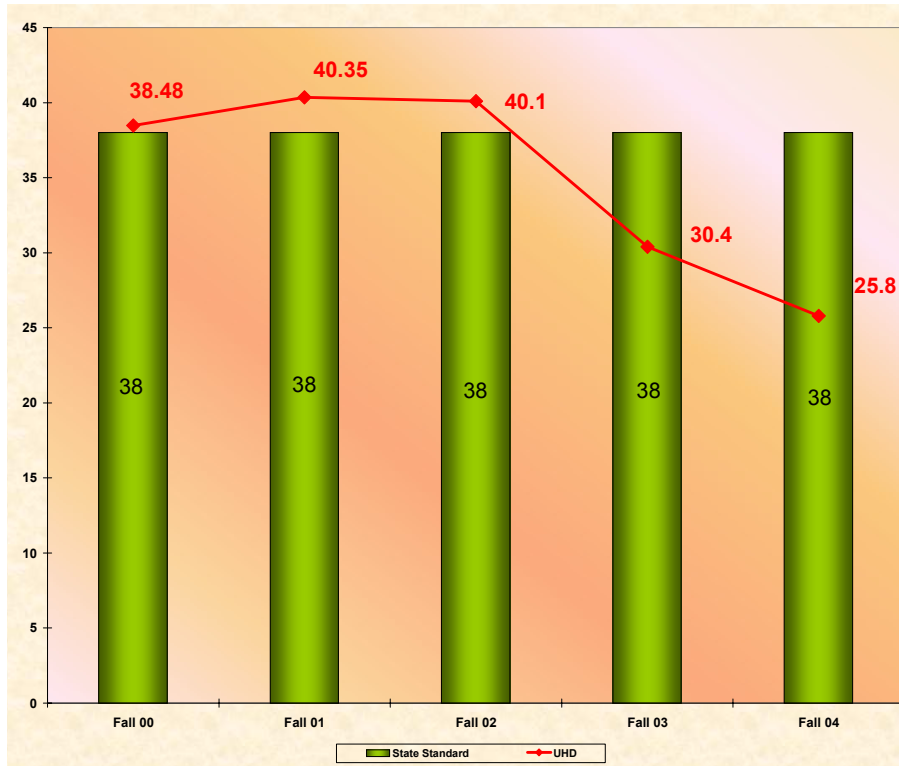

UHD Average Classroom Use and State of Texas Classroom Standard

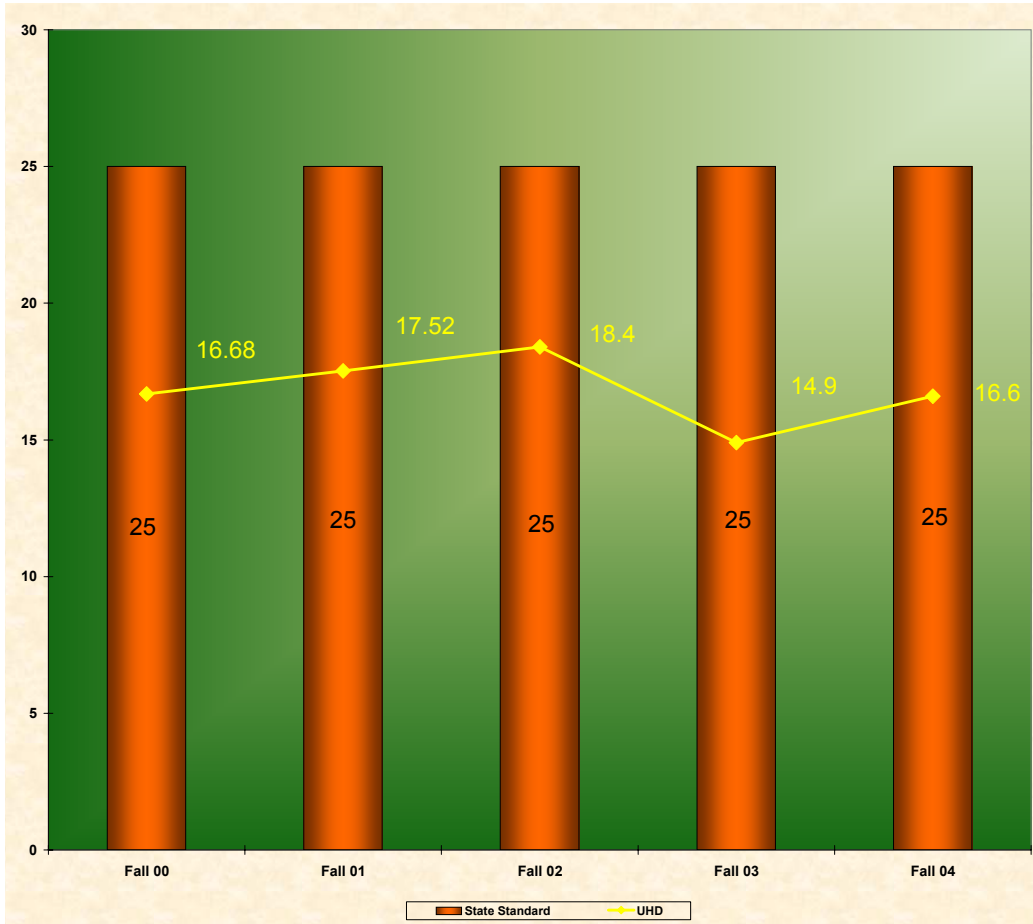

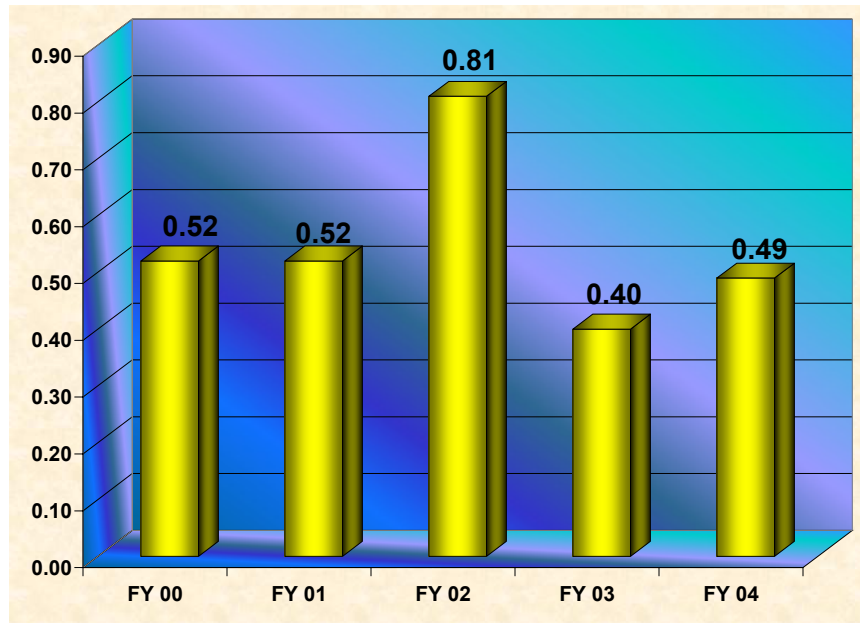

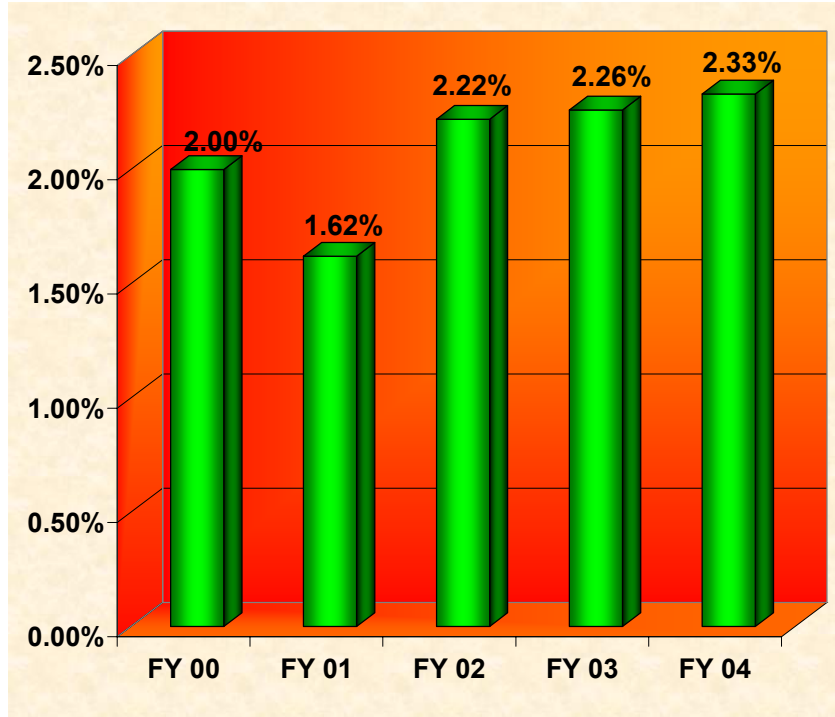

DAY/NIGHT/WEEKEND STATUS Refers to the time the class is held.

Weekend	Exclusively scheduled Friday, Saturday, or Sunday
Special	Usually a non-organized class in which time is arranged per meeting

FIRST-TIME, FULL-TIME FRESHMEN (FTIC) First - time (FTIC) are students who enroll with no previous college credit hours. Students who enter during the summer sessions and continue as full-time students the following fall semester are included with entering fall freshmen. Full-time is defined as taking 12 semester credit hours. For UHD admission purposes only, full-time freshmen are defined as students entering with 15 hours of credit or less.

FULL-TIME EQUIVALENCY (FTE)

Faculty & Staff Number of positions (FTE) is calculated by totaling all budgeted full-time (1.00 FTE) and part-time (<.50 FTE) positions. Student workers are not included.

Student State of Texas defines a full-time undergraduate student as one who carries 15 or more semester credit hours per fall or spring semester while full-time graduate status is defined as 12 hours. Federal definition declares undergraduate full-time status at 12 hours and graduate full-time status at 9 hours.

GRADUATION RATES Cohorts of first-time freshmen and college transfers who first enrolled in a fall semester. It also includes those first-time freshmen and college transfers who enrolled in the summer session and returned to enroll full-time in the subsequent fall semester. Full-time freshmen are defined at enrollment in 12 hours or more.

IPEDS (Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System) IPEDS is the basic reporting series used by the Department of Education to collect higher education data.

NUMBER OF COURSE COMPLETERS A State of Texas performance measure defined as the number of semester credit hours for which students are enrolled on the last day of the semester divided by the number of semester credit hours for which students were enrolled on the 12th class day.

PERCENT OF FRESHMEN RETAINED AFTER ONE ACADEMIC YEAR A State of Texas performance measure defined as the percentage of those students classified as first-time, full-time, degree-seeking freshmen who enter in the fall semester and enroll the following fall semester. Students who enter during the summer sessions and continue as full-time during the fall semester are included with entering fall freshmen. Full-time is defined as taking 12 semester credit hours during the fall semester. Hours in remediation are counted in determining full-time status.

PERCENT OF FRESHMEN WHO EARN A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE WITHIN 6 YEARS A State of Texas performance measure defined as the percentage of those students classified as first-time, full-time, degree-seeking freshmen who have earned a baccalaureate degree within six years of their entrance as freshmen.

MINORITY ENROLLMENT A State of Texas performance measure, minority enrollment is defined as the number of Hispanic, African-American, and Native-American students enrolled. Does not include Asian-American or International students.

MINORITY GRADUATES A State of Texas performance measure. See MINORITY ENROLLMENT for inclusion groups.

RACE/ETHNIC IDENTIFICATION The concept of race as used by the Equal Employment Commission does not denote clear-cut scientific definitions of anthropological origins. For the purposes of reporting, an employee or student may be included in the group to which he or she appears to belong, identifies with, or is regarded in the community as belonging.

White not of Hispanic Origin: having origin in any of the original people of Europe, North Africa, or the Middle East.

Black not of Hispanic Origin: having origin in any of the Black racial groups of Africa.

Hispanic of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture or origin regardless of race.

Asian or Pacific Islander having origin in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, the Pacific Islands or the Indian sub-continent. This area includes, for example, China, India, Japan, Korea, and the Philippine Islands.

RETENTION RATES Cohorts consist of first-time freshmen and college transfers who first enrolled in a fall semester. It also includes those first-time freshmen and college transfers who enrolled in the summer session and returned to enroll full-time in the subsequent fall semester. Full-time freshmen are defined as enrollment in 12 hours or more.

SPACE UTILIZATION RATE A State of Texas performance measure, the rate is defined as the average weekly hours of classrooms/ class labs usage as reported to the Coordinating Board on the Building and Room Use Report (CBM 005).
