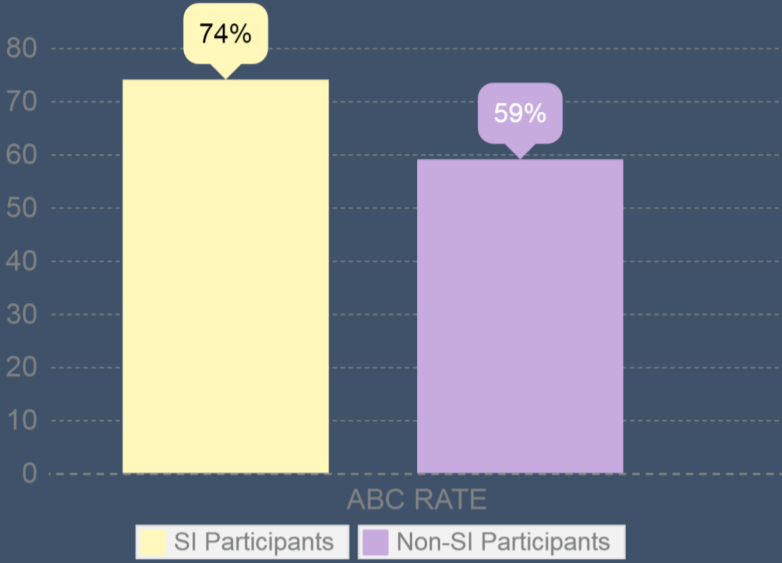


IMPACT OF SI ON GRADES FALL 2016

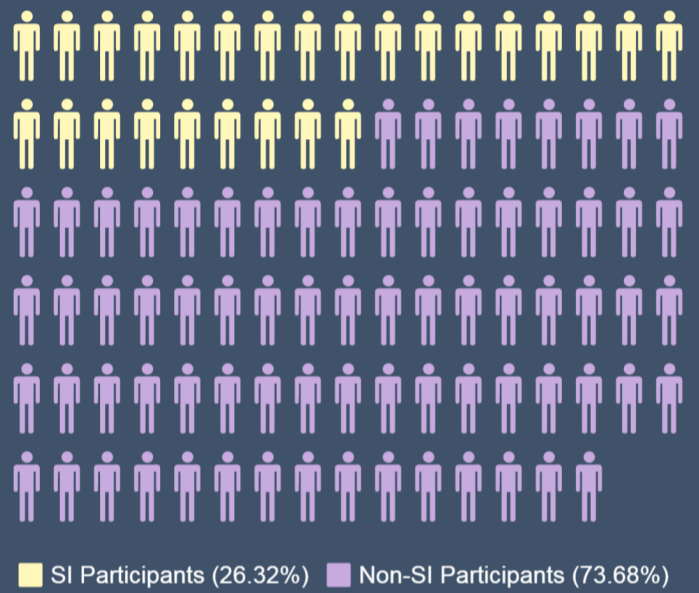
OVERVIEW



In Fall 2016, the University of Houston-Downtown SI Program offered over 1,200 sessions with an average of 3 students attending per session.

Across all sections, 62% of students who attended SI came to sessions more than once.

Withdrawals



The data above represents the percentage of withdrawals per group divided by the total number of students in SI sections who withdrew.

- 42%** Overall attendance to SI sessions
- 3801** Number of contact hours
- 0.5** GPA difference between SI participants and non-participants

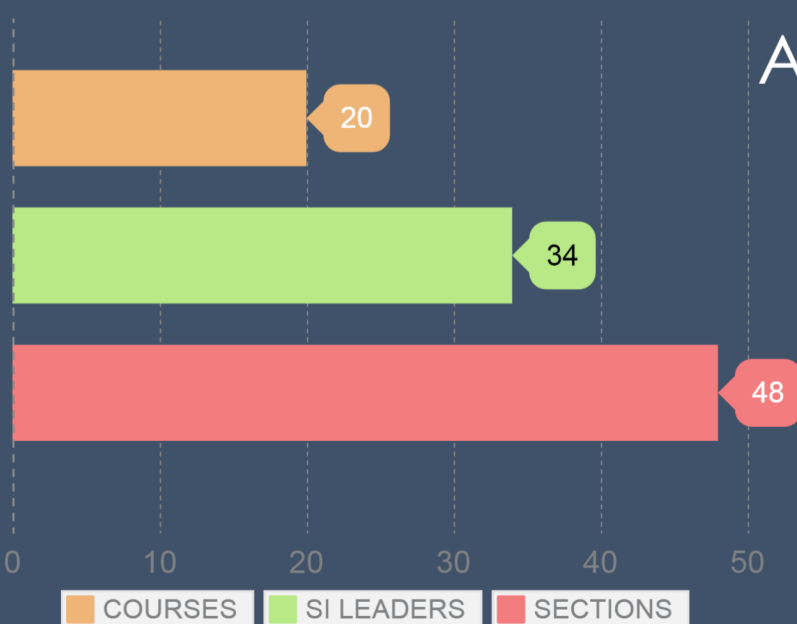
